



Mountain Road Reserve 2020 + CABERNET SAUVIGNON + PASO ROBLES

WINE ENTHUSIAST 95 POINTS

The fruit for the Mountain Road Reserve grows in the Adelaida District, at an elevation of 1,900 feet and only 12 miles from the Pacific Coast. Situated in the rugged coastal mountains west of Paso Robles, this prime vineyard site features rocky calcareous soils and southwestern exposures that lend themselves to producing stunning wines. It is here that the grapes for our award-winning Suendero are also grown.

This special selection focuses on very small lots of limited-production Cabernet Sauvignon, with a bit of Petit Verdot and Cabernet Franc in the blend to enhance the structure of the finished wine. To achieve a balanced style with a rich character and refined mouthfeel, the wine was aged for 20 months in French oak barrels before bottling unfined and unfiltered.

AROMA: Boysenberry, cassis with notes of dark chocolate, violets and a hint of amaretto Fullbodied, lively acidity, boysenberry, dark chocolate with an enveloping chewy yet rich
