### The Wine

Vina Robles Signature represents the hallmark blend of the vintage, unconstrained by convention and crafted to showcase the best expression of Paso Robles in a single wine. Bold, deeply colored, and richly textured, this wine is built for longevity while remaining beautifully balanced and expressive in its youth.

### Varietal Composition

60% Cabernet Sauvignon, 24% Petite Sirah, 16% Petit Verdot

### Vintage Notes

The 2022 growing season in Paso Robles was defined by warm, dry conditions that encouraged excellent ripeness and flavor concentration. Cool nighttime temperatures helped preserve acidity and structure, resulting in wines of depth, balance, and aging potential. Careful vineyard management and selective blending were key to achieving harmony in this Signature cuvée.

### Vineyard Notes

Fruit for the Signature blend is sourced from Vina Robles estate vineyards across Paso Robles including Bear Valley and Creston Valley Vineyards, where diverse soils, elevations, and exposures allow each variety to contribute its strongest attributes. These sites consistently produce fruit known for intense color, generous flavor, and rich, age-worthy tannins.

### Winemaking

Each varietal component was harvested in the cool early morning hours to preserve freshness and integrity. Fruit was carefully sorted, gently destemmed, and fermented in temperature-controlled stainless steel tanks with tailored pump-over regimes to optimize extraction and balance. The wine was aged for 20 months in French oak barrels, allowing the individual components to integrate fully before final blending and bottling.

### Tasting Notes

Deep and nearly opaque in the glass, the 2022 Signature opens with layered aromas of black cherry, blackberry, and cassis, accented by notes of violet, blue fruit, and subtle spice. The palate is rich and mouth-filling, with Cabernet Sauvignon providing structure and dark fruit, Petit Verdot contributing color, blue fruit, and floral lift, and Petite Sirah adding layers of creamy tannins and depth. The finish is long, polished, and age-worthy, offering power with poise and balance.
