## 2022 Suendero PASO ROBLES

### The Wine

Named after “Sueño Sendero,” or the “Dream Path,” Suendero is a modern Paso Robles Meritage that balances power with elegance. Rich, layered, and deeply structured, this limited-production blend reflects the rugged beauty and coastal influence of the Adelaida District while showcasing refinement, texture, and age-worthy depth.

### Varietal Composition

56% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Malbec, 14% Petite Verdot,  
10% Cabernet Franc

### Vintage Notes

The 2022 growing season in Paso Robles was warm and dry, producing fruit with exceptional concentration and intensity. Cooling marine influence from the Pacific Ocean helped preserve freshness and structure, while careful vineyard management and small-lot winemaking resulted in wines of richness, balance, and longevity.

### Vineyard Notes

Suendero is sourced from a small ranch vineyard in the Adelaida District, perched at approximately 1,700 feet elevation and located just 12 miles from the Pacific Ocean. The site’s rugged hillsides feature calcareous soils formed from uplifted ancient seabeds, while constant marine breezes moderate the warm Paso Robles climate. These unique growing conditions produce fruit of remarkable concentration, balance, and complexity.

### Winemaking

At harvest, the grapes were hand-picked, sorted, destemmed, and gently crushed into small fermenters. Frequent pump-overs and punch-downs were used throughout fermentation to extract balanced color, flavor, and texture from the concentrated berries. Following fermentation, the wine was gently pressed into limited-production, tight-grained French oak barrels for 20 months.

### Tasting Notes

Dark ruby in color, the 2022 Suendero opens with expressive aromas of black raspberry, blueberry, violets, and dark chocolate. Full-bodied and richly textured, the palate delivers layers of mixed dark berries, cocoa, and subtle spice, framed by fine, chewy tannins that provide both structure and elegance. The finish is long, polished, and deeply layered, showcasing the balance and sophistication of this Adelaida District blend.
