The Wine

A striking single-vineyard expression, the 2023 Creston Valley Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon is gorgeously rich and unctuous, intensely aromatic, and nearly opaque in color. Concentrated and structured, it is both powerful and age-worthy.

Varietal Composition

100% Cabernet Sauvignon

Vintage Notes

The 2023 vintage in Paso Robles offered a long and steady growing season with warm days and cool nights, allowing Cabernet Sauvignon to develop exceptional depth of flavor while preserving natural acidity. Even ripening and balanced conditions produced wines of richness, vibrancy, and longevity.

Vineyard Notes

Sourced from two small blocks in the Creston Valley Vineyard at 1,300 feet elevation, planted to low-yielding Cabernet Sauvignon clones. With southerly exposed slopes, gravelly calcareous soils, and naturally low yields, this vineyard produces fruit of extraordinary intensity, color, and structure—perfect for crafting a rich and cellar-worthy Cabernet Sauvignon.

Winemaking

Harvested in the cool early morning to preserve freshness, the clusters were hand-sorted and then passed through an optical sorter to retain only the most concentrated berries. Fermentation was carried out in small, temperature-controlled stainless steel tanks with tailored pump-overs to maximize color, texture, and tannin extraction. The wine was then aged for 18 months in select tight-grained French and Hungarian oak barrels, adding layers of spice and complexity while maintaining balance and refinement.

Tasting Notes

The 2023 Creston Valley Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon is nearly opaque in the glass, offering an aromatic rush of blackberry, black cherry, and crème de cassis. On the palate, it is gorgeously rich and velvety in texture, layered with notes of roasted coffee, dark chocolate, and toasted coconut. Hints of German chocolate cake and orange peel add depth and intrigue, while firm, age-worthy tannins provide structure. The finish is long, powerful, and polished—an exceptional single-vineyard expression of Paso Robles Cabernet Sauvignon.
