The Wine

A richer, denser barrel selection of our Paso Robles Cabernet Sauvignon, this Limited Selection bottling highlights the depth, concentration, and structure of the vintage. Crafted in small quantities, it represents the finest lots chosen from across our favorite vineyards.

Varietal Composition

91% Cabernet Sauvignon, 7% Petit Verdot, 1% Cabernet Franc, 1% Malbec

Vintage Notes

The 2023 growing season in Paso Robles provided steady, balanced conditions with warm, sunny days and cool nights. Extended hang time allowed Cabernet Sauvignon to develop optimal ripeness, yielding fruit of exceptional richness, vibrant aromatics, and natural structure—perfect for a reserve-style selection.

Vineyard Notes

Sourced from five Vina Robles estate vineyards across Paso Robles: Creston Valley, El Pomar, Estrella, Geneseo, and Adelaida Districts. Together, these diverse sites bring balance and complexity to the blend, combining mountain-grown intensity with valley-floor vibrancy.

Winemaking

Fruit was harvested in the cool early morning, then hand-sorted, gently destemmed, and passed through an optical sorter to ensure only the highest quality berries were used. Fermentation took place in small, temperature-controlled stainless steel tanks with regular pump-overs for optimal extraction of color, flavor, and tannin. The wine was aged in French, Hungarian, and American oak barrels for 18 months. Following intensive tastings, only the most expressive and powerful barrels were chosen for this Limited Selection Cabernet Sauvignon.

Tasting Notes

The 2023 Limited Selection Cabernet Sauvignon offers intensely concentrated aromas of black cherry, blackberry compote, and cassis, layered with notes of cedar, vanilla bean, and dark spice. The palate is dense and powerful, delivering layers of ripe black fruit, mocha, and savory dried herbs framed by bold yet polished tannins. Hints of toasted oak, espresso, and spice carry through the long, structured finish, showcasing a wine built for both immediate impact and graceful aging.
