2024 Vermentino PASO ROBLES

The Wine

Bright, aromatic, and refreshing, the 2024 Vermentino offers a crisp Mediterranean-inspired expression of Paso Robles. This wine highlights vibrant fruit, floral lift, and a mineral-driven finish, making it a versatile partner for a variety of dishes or an invigorating sip on its own.

Vintage Notes

The 2024 growing season in Paso Robles was marked by moderate temperatures and an extended ripening period, allowing Vermentino to fully develop its aromatic range and crisp acidity. Warm days brought concentration and intensity to the fruit, while cool nights preserved freshness and energy in the finished wine.

Vineyard Notes

Sourced exclusively from the Huerhuero Vineyard on the east side of Paso Robles, where warm daytime temperatures, cool evening breezes, and well-drained alluvial soils provide the ideal environment for Vermentino to thrive. The vineyard's unique mesoclimate produces fruit with lively acidity and layered complexity.

Winemaking

Grapes were harvested in the early morning to retain freshness, then whole-cluster pressed to preserve delicate aromatics. Fermentation took place in stainless steel tanks at cool temperatures to capture fruit vibrancy, followed by 8 months of aging in neutral oak barrels to add subtle texture without overpowering the wine's natural character. No malolactic fermentation was conducted, ensuring a crisp and clean profile.

Tasting Notes

Aromas of Meyer lemon, green apple, and white peach mingle with hints of orange blossom and fresh herbs. The palate is bright and zesty, offering flavors of citrus zest, pear, and a touch of sea spray minerality. A supple midpalate from barrel aging leads into a refreshing, mouthwatering finish that lingers with notes of lemon verbena and a saline freshness. The fruit flavors, balanced by a streak of lively acidity drives the wine to a crisp, refreshing finish.
