The Wine

Bright, expressive, and distinctly tropical, the 2025 Sauvignon Blanc highlights a shift toward a more fruit-driven profile with less herbaceous character than previous vintages. The result is a vibrant, aromatic wine with lifted florals, juicy texture, and a long, refreshing finish.

Varietal Composition

100% Sauvignon Blanc

Vintage Notes

The 2025 growing season in Paso Robles featured a warm, even ripening period with moderate daytime temperatures and cool evenings. These conditions allowed Sauvignon Blanc to develop ripe tropical flavors and aromatic intensity while maintaining fresh acidity. The vintage is marked by purity of fruit, balance, and vibrant energy.

Vineyard Notes

Sourced from select vineyard blocks across Paso Robles, including sites with well-drained sandy and gravelly soils that promote bright aromatics and focused fruit expression. These vineyards benefit from warm days and cooling coastal influences, ideal for developing Sauvignon Blanc with both richness and freshness.

Winemaking

Grapes were whole-cluster pressed to preserve delicate aromatics, then fermented in a combination of stainless steel tanks and neutral oak barrels. No malolactic fermentation was conducted, allowing the wine to retain its natural acidity and freshness. The integration of neutral oak adds subtle texture and complexity without overshadowing the fruit.

Tasting Notes

The 2025 Sauvignon Blanc is vibrant and expressive, opening with aromas of guava, white melon, and delicate floral notes. The palate is juicy and fruit-driven, showcasing flavors of gum drop candy, white grape juice, and Crenshaw melon, complemented by subtle wet stone minerality. A touch of graham cracker crust from neutral oak adds texture and intrigue, leading to a long, lively, and refreshing finish.
